FY20 Budget to Date Summary: Fencl distributed the FY20 budget to date table and described how the ICWMA funds are tracked in general and for the match to the Soil Health Partnership. The FY20 budget to date will be a reoccurring item on future agendas.

Soil Health Partnership Project: Davis provided his annual grant report and described his accomplishments including:

- Over 1,300 acres of cover crop commitments for fall of 2019. The goal is 5,000 acres over 5 years.
- Locations identified for 5 bioreactor/ saturated buffer sites. The goal is 5 sites over 5 years.
- Cover crop field day August 14, 2019 at the Marion Airport with almost 60 farmers attending.

Lower Cedar WMA Planning Grant: Fencl reported that the Lower Cedar WMA was successful in their planning proposal to the DNR and will receive \$100,000 for a watershed plan.

Indian Creek Watershed Management Plan Update: Fencl reported that the 20-year watershed plan is due for an update. The Board requested that Fencl provide a proposal to complete a "mini-update" to compile new data and accomplishments at the next meeting.

Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) accepting Notice of Interest: Fencl reported that Linn County did not get asked to submit a full application for their Hydrology Study.

Urban stormwater practices in Creek View Cove: no update.
