Lower Cedar WMA Planning Grant & Indian Creek Watershed Management Plan 2020 Update: Fencl proposed leveraging existing organizational management support to ECIOCG for potential work on the Lower Cedar Watershed Management Plan. ECICOG is partnering with FYRA Engineering on a proposal to do the Lower Cedar Plan. If successful, Fencl requested approval to devote some organizational management time on the plan with the understanding that the Indian Creek Watershed Plan would also get updated through the process.
